


About EDGE

How we work with businesses

The partnership gives companies access to targeted recruitment and training services, developing the skills that business need, be that by developing your existing workforce or preparing new recruits to meet your needs.





How EDGE can work with you

- Recruitment and jobs brokerage service – EDGE works with businesses: matching people to job opportunities, identifying skills gaps within your company and co-ordinating options to help you respond.
- Supporting apprenticeship programmes and apprentice matching service – working with companies, local schools, colleges and specialist trainers to develop schemes and people to meet your needs.
- Work experience and work trial programmes – co-ordinating between businesses, schools, colleges and the Job Centre, to provide placement opportunities for all ages.
- Business support access to free business surgeries through the HDC Economic Development Team and reports on market intelligence and skills surveys both locally and nationally.
- Co-ordinating business input on curriculum – liaising with businesses and schools to shape school curriculum and prepare students for the workplace and specific industries.
